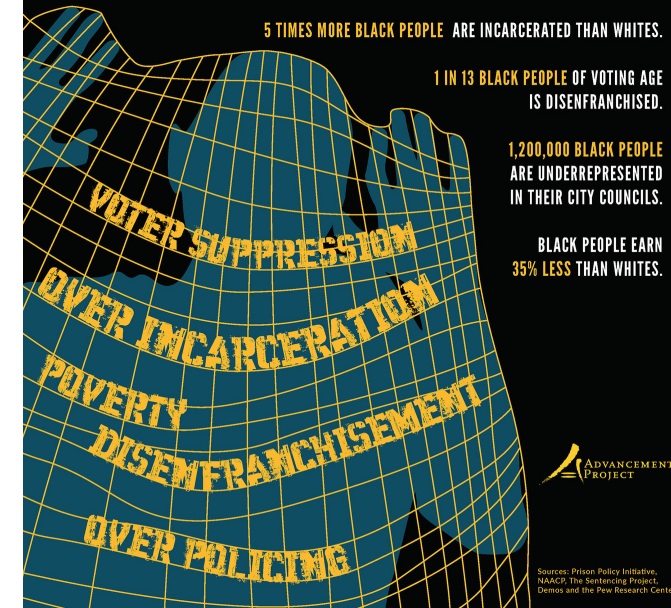
2,300,000 PEOPLE ARE INCARCERATED IN THE U.S.

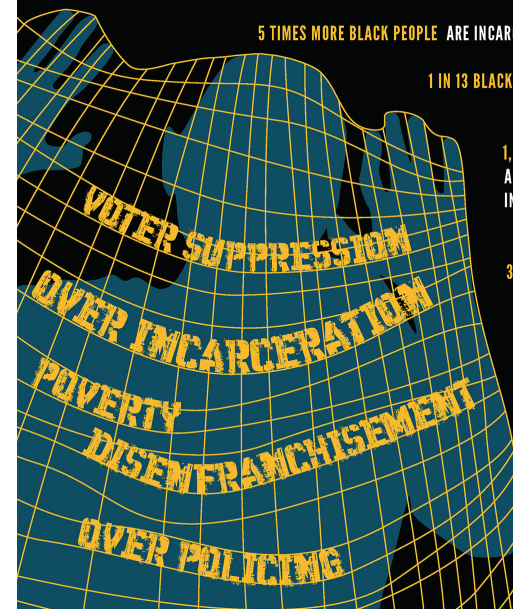

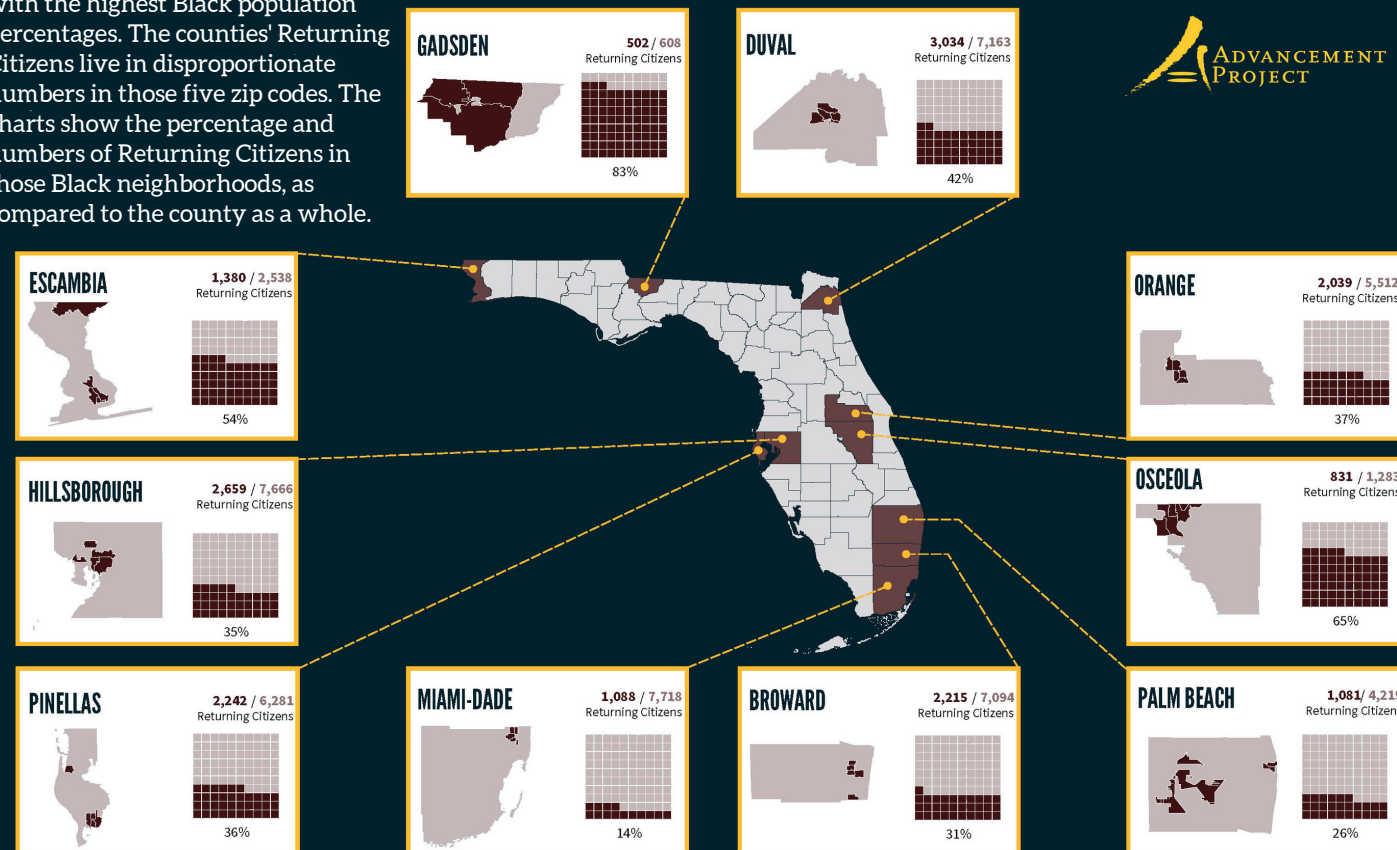
FOR RETURNING CITIZENS IN FLORIDA



Historically racist and unfair laws disenfranchise communities of color throughout Florida. Voter suppression has undermined the voice and democratic will of our communities. **1.68 million people are fully denied the right to vote due to Florida's felon disenfranchisement policies. 1 in 5 African American eligible voters is disenfranchised.**

DISPROPORTIONATE IMPACT ON BLACK NEIGHBORHOODS

The dark shaded areas on each county map reflects the five zip codes with the highest Black population percentages. The counties' Returning Citizens live in disproportionate numbers in those five zip codes. The charts show the percentage and numbers of Returning Citizens in those Black neighborhoods, as compared to the county as a whole.



KNOW WHAT'S ON THE BALLOT: AMENDMENT 4

Amendment 4 is Florida's Voter Restoration Amendment which would restore voting rights to people with felony convictions who have served their sentence, including parole and probation, with the exception of those convicted of murder and sexual offenses.

Advancement Project's national office aided partners in developing language for the ballot initiative including FL SEIU 1199, New Florida Majority, Dream Defenders and Florida Immigrant Coalition (FLIC).
