

DECLARATION OF NICHOLAS MARIO CIRIELLO

My name is Nicholas Mario Ciriello. I am over the age of 18 and fully competent to make this declaration. Under penalty of perjury, I state the following:

1. I am a resident of Miami-Dade County.
2. I am registered to vote in Miami-Dade County.
3. I identify as white Hispanic.
4. I had a plan to vote in the 2020 presidential preference primary.
5. My plan to vote was to vote in person at my assigned polling place on Tuesday, March 17, 2020.
6. On or about Monday, March 9, I became sick.
7. For the next two weeks, my symptoms included a fever, chills, coughing, severe headaches, and diarrhea.
8. I understood that these symptoms overlapped with the core symptoms of COVID-19.
9. I believe that I was infected with COVID-19.
10. By Tuesday, March 17, 2020, my symptoms had not cleared or improved.
11. I understood that I would risk spreading my infection to others in my community if I carried out my plan to vote in person, so I tried to find another way to vote.
12. I called several hotlines, including the Election Protection hotline, and received information about the possibility of receiving an Election Day vote-by-mail ballot delivered by a family member.
13. My sister was unable to help deliver a ballot to me because she was unwell herself on Tuesday, March 17, 2020.
14. My ex-mother-in-law was unable to help deliver a ballot to me because her employer was still requiring her to report to work.
15. No other family members were available to help deliver a ballot to me.
16. The coronavirus outbreak, and what I believe was my own infection with COVID-19, disrupted my plan to vote in the 2020 presidential preference primary.

17. I was unable to vote in the 2020 presidential preference primary.

18. I feel horrible that I was unable to vote. This year, I especially wanted to show my support for my candidate of choice—and I strongly believe that my vote can make a difference.

19. I fear that if the state does not take action to make voting accessible to responsible people who choose to self-quarantine, many others could be disenfranchised in the upcoming elections.
